The ability to bypass low waters ...

... is the key to exceptional Peacock Bass fishing. Sport fishing yachts, commercial fishing boats and even survival fishing must stop where low water prevents passage, and beyond these barriers is where the great fishing starts! Our highly mobile Fly-In Floating Cabins are 4 - 6 hours upriver (even in a super fast bass boat) from these fringe locations.



Drawing only 4 inches of water, our Fly-In Floating Cabins navigate past shallow water natural barriers in comfort and style.



We whisk our small 8-guest parties, from Manaus directly to our comfortable, Floating Cabins on a turbo prop-Cessna Cessiva Flyplane.



Although many land based lodges, including our Shufar and Tapera Lodges, are situated past these natural barriers, they have no ability to seek better water levels. Plus their areas become rapidly overfished 2 to 3 hours upriver or downriver. Our cabins, however, move daily to unfished river segments overrighing along Caribbean-like beaches.

Floating Cabins MOBILITY AND COMFORT

Heavy duty vinyl outside roof, walls and outside shades, with a 7' ceiling, insulation, allows temperatures to be a comfortable 70° at 6 p.m. and a cool 65° at 10 p.m. Inevitably, for the depleted, Fly-In Floating Cabins II is fully air conditioned. The new 270 square foot cabins have large panoramic view windows on all four sides and private bathroom with hot and cold, instant shower and toilet service.



Draws only 4 inches of water. All fully welded aluminum exterior. Easy and fast bottom passage, built in outrigger dragging over sand or rocky riprap.

The Outfitter

Does not travel by the massive private in the jungle and landing strips of South America, Los Pezanos was situated in the United States, receiving an MA from the Whittier School of Finance. Los Pezanos since 1981 holds the title of Peacock Bass fishing with approximately 100,000 lbs of various, facilities and comfort. It houses the steadily increasing anglers have come to expect and to the experience, local conservation and local country every to provide an exceptional fishing experience.

Boats

With a 12' gun leaning stern or bow to overcome the Amazon's shallow sand bars in order to reach remote isolated areas, we have gone from the attractive but ineffective U.S. high speed run boats to our today's shallow draft low boats to our today's shallow draft low boats. They are 21' long with all the standard boat features (padding, motor, high speed seats, fishing platforms etc.) yet they are still sufficiently light to be ported to numerous tight fishing opportunities.

The Guides

River Plate guides are undoubtedly the best in the business. Most Amazon outflows employ poorly trained, uneducated "boat drivers." River Plate's carefully trained guides are best one spot fishermen who are intimately familiar with the complexities of Amazon fishing. They have guided the River Plate for over 10 years. With thousands of fish boats for clients, they've got you with big catches of big fish like no one else in the Amazon.

Tackle

The local market and that plus weight restrictions, we provide top quality bait-casting rods and reels of all size applications.

Fish Tagging Project

In 2004, River Plate began sponsoring the first long term official tagging project with the Amazon Research Institute to determine the impact on Peacock Bass populations of "weird and wobbler" fishing.

Indian Reservations

River Plate is the only outfitter in Brazil that has legally obtained fishing permits for Indian reserves by negotiating in good faith with the Brazilian government authorities. These permits work potentially bringing commercial (for profit) fishing, in our arrangements greatly benefit the Indian tribes by generating local, never currency and stability in their delicate economies. We operate with "zero tolerance" practices, spending very little actual time in the individual groups or within in the fishing boat or camp and setting in our fishing releases, and by using many biodegradable products and carefully removing all garbage and signs of our presence.

Preserving the Rainforest

Contribution of the environmental role, River Plate has created with the Amazon Conservancy a total of 2.5 million acres in Preservation Parks in the River basins of the Maracá, Marajó, Tapajós, and Madeira Rivers. Between 1990 and 2000, River Plate distributed the equivalent of 18 tons of food to more of these Parks in recognition for creating environmental safety. We have also donated a great deal of money to pay for park entrance and their support organizations.

Humanitarian Aid

In 1994, River Plate built a medical care facility for the County of Maracá, and in 2000 donated 20 acres of rubber land to the town of Encarnação for public housing for homeless people subjects. We will continue to provide food and monetary support to single communities and individuals reached by our angling operations.

RIVER PLATE OUTFITTERS' UNIQUE APPROACH LITERALLY OUTDISTANCES THE COMPETITION

- We fly our clients directly to remote highly mobile floating cabins, no long boat rides, no time wasted in getting to prime fishing areas.
- Travel times to fish each day average 10 - 20 minutes. Other operators routinely travel one to two hours or more from fixed lodges or large hotel boats.
- Our unique mobility allows us to fish in areas above natural barriers: shallow water, sandbars, and rapids that prevent passage of sport fishing yachts and commercial fishing boats. These are no expensive daily fly-outs. There are no crowded waters.
- We do not overfish. We move on to fresh water every few days. Our guests catch double or triple the number of fish that guests with other operators catch.
- Our small groups—eight anglers maximum—enjoy personal service and access to pristine waters that seldom see a lure. Other operators take as many as 30 guests per week!
