



## ITINERARY **BRAZIL – AGUA BOA**

**\*\*Please note: Itinerary is subject to revision due to changes in flight schedules, weather and other operational factors.\*\***  
Be sure to have your valid passport and Brazilian tourist visa. **\*\* Please resist the tendency to over-pack. For to the charter flight, a 45-pound luggage weight plus 5-pound carry-on limit is enforced.** Please resist the tendency to over pack.  
**\*\*Remember the lodge has daily laundry service.\*\***

### **Day One HOME AIRPORT-MIAMI**

Plan to arrive at the airport no later than 2 hours prior to departure.

*(Please advise domestic flight schedule)*

Upon arrival, precede to the Miami International Airport Hotel, located in concourse E, level 2. Overnight at hotel & meals on own.

### **Day Two MIAMI-MANAUS**

Plan to arrive at check-in no later than 3 hours prior to departure. **Please note early morning departure.**

*(Flight schedule to be advised)*

After clearing immigration and customs in Manaus, you will be met by our representative, and transferred to the Hotel Tropical. Enjoy the rest of the day at leisure in Manaus. Overnight at hotel and meals on own.

### **Day Three MANAUS-AGUA BOA LODGE**

Early this morning you will be transferred to the airport for the charter flight to the fishery and camp.

*(Note: Many variables are involved in accessing these remote camps on a constantly changing selection of fishing rivers. Access is by floatplane or fixed-wheel aircraft to remote jungle airstrips. Please be patient and understanding with the arrival logistics for your party.)*

On arrival at the lodge, a champagne breakfast will be waiting. You'll get a brief orientation by the camp host and then you will meet your guide. After which you will begin your fly-fishing adventure for peacock bass. Overnight lodge.

### **Day Four through Day Nine PEACOCK BASS FISHING**

Clients will fish two to a boat with one guide. Guides have been trained extensively and have many years of experience guiding for peacock bass. They are conversant in fishing English and will understand your needs. After breakfast, you are welcome to fish with your guide until 6:00 PM. The rivers and tributaries around the Agua Boa Lodge are rich and diverse. Possible species include the three species of peacocks: the butterfly (up to 10 pounds), the paca or spotted (up to 20 pounds), and the temensis (up to 24 pounds) The current peacock record stands at 27 pounds.

Peacock Bass are perhaps one of the toughest gamefish around. Their topwater strike is often so ferocious that the entire fish will fly several feet out of the water with the fly. Once hooked peacocks exhibit a savvy toughness unknown to trout and largemouth bass fisherman. A large peacock is unstoppable on its first few runs. In addition to peacock bass, other gamefish present include: payara, piranha, pirapatinga, matrinxã, pirarucu, aruana, jancunda, traíra, surubim and countless other species. The "Ecotourism Reserve" status has insured that river and the forest that surrounds it will be protected for years to come. Sportfishing is allowed on a catch and release basis.

### **AGUA BOA LODGE-MANAUS-MIAMI-HOME**

Today you'll return by charter flight to Manaus. On arrival in Manaus, you will be transferred to the international airport for your departure.

*(Flight schedule to be advised)*

Upon arrival in Miami you will connect with your flight home or overnight in Miami at Miami Airport Hotel. Overnight and meals on own.

*(Please advise domestic flight schedule)*
