



SAMPLE ITINERARY MEXICO – EI SALTO

Day One

HOME AIRPORT-MAZATLAN-EL SALTO

Plan to arrive at the airport no later than 3 hours prior to departure.

(Please advise flight schedule)

Bienvenidos! On arrival In Mazatlan, you will be met by our representative and shuttled to Anglers Inn Resort El Salto, located on the waters edge with spectacular views, air-conditioned suites, with private bath, TV/VCR, built-in safes, hair dryers, and smoke alarms. Also a restaurant, bar, satellite TV and tackle shop are all on site. Maid service is provided twice daily. On arrival, you will receive a cool drink and a warm welcome. Dinner and overnight at the lodge.

Day Two though Day Four

LARGEMOUTH BASS FISHING ON EL SALTO

After an early breakfast, you head out to Lake El Salto to experience the best largemouth bass fishing south of the border. You'll fish two to a boat, accompanied by an experienced local guide. The number of fish landed will be determined by the skill level of the angler, but it is safe to say that even the novice angler will be delighted with the fast and furious action on Lake El Salto. Topwater baits work well early and late in the day and during cloud cover. Anglers proficient at working spinnerbaits around shallow cover will really enjoy this lake. It is also a worm angler's heaven. Large, deep running crankbaits target larger bass. You'll fish from Tracker bass boats with 48 h.p. outboards, electric trolling motors, and swivel seats. At noon, you'll break for lunch and siesta before resuming fishing in the afternoon. You'll return to the camp at dusk for drinks and a delicious dinner. Overnight at the lodge.

Day Five

EL SALTO-MAZATLAN-MEXICO CITY-ATLANTA

After breakfast this morning, you'll be shuttled back to the airport for you departure flight.

(Please advise flight schedule)

NOTE: A PASSPORT WITH RAISED SEAL IS REQUIRED FOR ENTRY TO MEXICO.

RECONFIRM FLIGHTS 72 HOURS PRIOR TO DEPARTURE.

CHECK IN AT LEAST 3 HOURS PRIOR TO INTERNATIONAL FLIGHTS; 2 HOUR FOR DOMESTIC FLIGHTS
