



SAMPLE ITINERARY

Costa Rica – Crocodile Bay Lodge

(Please resist the urge to over pack. Due to the charter plane from San Jose to the Lodge, luggage weight should not exceed 30 pounds per passenger. A surcharge will apply for any additional weight. Laundry service at the Lodge is available. VISA is the preferred charge card of Costa Rica.)

Day One

USA-SAN JOSE

Plan to arrive at airport no later than 3 hours prior to departure.

(Please advise flight schedule)

On arrival in San Jose, after clearing immigrations and customs, you will be met by our representative. They will transfer you to Hotel Melia Cariari. Overnight hotel (meals on own).

Day Two

SAN JOSE-CROCODILE BAY LODGE

This morning you will be transferred to airport for your flight to Puerto Jimenez where the lodge is located. Crocodile Bay Lodge is a first-class resort adjacent to some of Costa Rica's most beautiful beaches. It sits on its own 44-acres of tropical gardens on the Osa Peninsula, which has been described by National Geographic as the most ecologically intense place on earth. The air-conditioned rooms are spacious, with two queen-sized beds and a private deck. Other amenities include swimming pool, restaurant, and a rooftop observation deck. For non-anglers, the lodge offers a special eco-tour program featuring a variety of soft-adventure activities. After settling into your room, you'll enjoy a delicious breakfast and then head out for a day of fishing. Return to the lodge for dinner and relaxation. Overnight.

Day Three through Day Four

FISHING AT CROCODILE BAY LODGE

After breakfast, depart for full days of fishing. Inshore fishing along the volcanic shore is good all year. Minutes from the lodge you can fish from flats boats in the mangrove estuaries that feed the great Golfo dulce. Anglers can flycast, spincast or troll through the nooks and crannies of the of this tropical backcountry paradise, where big snook and other sportfish are waiting to explode on your bait. The volcanic shoreline offers great fishing for roosterfish, snapper, jack crevelle and other inshore species.

Alternatively, Hop aboard a Rambo 27-foot inboard for a thirty-minute run to blue water to catch sailfish, blue, black and striped marlin, as well as wahoo, dolphin and tuna. It is common to raise 10-15 sailfish a day. The Pacific coast of Costa Rica has earned the deserved reputation as having one of the largest populations of sailfish found anywhere in the world. This region also boasts the all-tackle world record Pacific black snook. Dinner and overnight at lodge.

Day Five

CROCODILE BAY LODGE-SAN JOSE-USA

This morning you will take your flight back to San Jose. From there you will connect with your international flight home.

NOTE: A VALID U.S. PASSPORT IS REQUIRED FOR ENTRY TO COSTA RICA. TOURIST CARD ISSUED DURING FLIGHT. RECONFIRM FLIGHTS 72 HOURS PRIOR TO DEPARTURE.

CHECK IN AT LEAST 3 HOURS PRIOR TO INTERNATIONAL FLIGHTS; 2 HOURS FOR DOMESTIC FLIGHTS.
