“Lion’s Roar, Tigerfish Soar”

FishQuest Southern Africa Adventure Safari

(Please note: Itinerary is subject to revision due to changes in flight schedules, weather and other operational factors. Be sure to have your valid passport).

Day One

USA-JOHANNESBURG

Plan to arrive at the airport no later than 3 hours prior to departure.

(Please advise flight schedule)

On arrival, you’ll be greeted by FishQuest!’s local representative and transferred to the Sandton Hotel. The afternoon is free to recover from travel fatigue and jet lag. Overnight.

World renowned for its superior accommodation and service, the Sandton Sun Hotel is one of Johannesburg’s most well known landmarks. With its convenient situation in the heart of the Central Business District of Sandton, this luxury hotel is easily accessible from the Johannesburg OR Tambo Airport, Johannesburg city centre and Pretoria.

Dining recommendation: Vilamoura Restaurant at Hotel.

Day Two

JOHANNESBURG-SUN CITY

This morning you’ll enjoy a delicious breakfast after which your pick up is scheduled for 11:00 am where you will be transferred about two hours to Sun City, where you’ll overnight in the luxurious Palace of the Lost City. The afternoon is free to hit the casino, play a round of golf, or just relax by the pool. Dine at the restaurant of your choice. Dinner recommendation: Villa Del Palazzo at the hotel. Overnight.

The Lost City is one of the most exciting and innovative tourist attractions in the world. This extraordinary hotel, with its towers of faux elephant tusks, boasts a fantasy of crystal staircases, hand-frescoed ceilings, semi-precious mosaic floors and sculptured palm fronds. The Palace looks down upon 62 acres of jungle and adventure waterpark and backs onto Sun City’s golf course.

The Palace has 338 rooms featuring 24-hour room service, multiple telephones, air-conditioning units, armoires & writing desks, a mini bar, a computerized safe and color satellite television with remote control.

Day Three

PALACE OF THE LOST CITY

This morning you’ll take an early morning game drive in Pilanesburg National Park. The park covers just over 138, 000 acres and lies inside an extinct volcano alkaline crater – one of only three in the world. You’ll depart on safari in open vehicles in search of the “Big Five” – elephant, lion, buffalo, leopard and black rhino. The park also has cheetah, giraffe, hippos and many more animals and birdlife to enjoy.

The afternoon is free to relax or take in the various activities available at Sun City. Dine at the restaurant of your choice. Dinner recommendation: The Crystal Court at the hotel. Overnight.

Day Four

SUN CITY- JOHANNESBURG-LUSAKA-CHIAWA SAFARI CAMP

You will be collected at 5:45 am for your private road transfer to the Johannesburg International Airport for the flight to Lusaka.

Johannesburg-Lusaka

On arrival in Lusaka, you'll board your separate charter flight to Jeki Airstrip by the camp.

Lusaka-Chiawa

(Flight schedule to be advised)

On arrival you'll be met by a camp representative who will ground transfer you to our camp. Overnight.

Day Five through Day Nine

LOWER ZAMBEZI RIVER – CHIAWA CAMP

Savor the full essence of an African safari – watching elephants, hippos, lions and other big game amid the stunning backdrop of the Zambezi River. Anglers can enjoy full days fishing for the legendary tigerfish, whose jarring strikes, lightning runs and acrobatic leaps challenge light-tackle and fly enthusiasts. There is a boat and guide reserved for you. Midday lunch breaks provide a nice respite from the sun and a chance to rest up before afternoon activities. Dinners will consist of a blend of western and local cuisine cooked up to satisfy even the hungriest of adventures. After dinner, all can take part in evening safari game drives, or simply relax in camp. Overnight at lodge.

Day Ten

CHIAWA CAMP-LIVINGSTONE

This morning you'll be transferred to Jeki Airstrip for our charter flight to Livingstone.

Upon arrival you'll be met and transferred to the Royal Livingstone Hotel. Afternoon and evening at leisure. Dining recommendation: The Dining room at the Hotel. Overnight.

The Royal Livingstone Hotel perfectly captures the opulence of a bygone era, encompassing romance and adventure in colonial style. Ten en-suite air-conditioned rooms make up each grand-estate inspired two-storey cluster where guests are housed. Each room has its own private balcony and terrace offering spectacular views of the Zambezi River and beyond. Dinner recommendation: The dining room at the hotel.

The Travelers Bar and Lounge is a place where guests can relax under thatched shade. With comfortable armchairs and low ottomans, guests enjoy high tea or linger over some fine port or a cigar. The a la carte restaurant serves a range of exquisite delicacies from around the world.

Day Eleven

VICTORIA FALLS AT LEISURE

Guided tour of Victoria Falls, one of the great natural wonders of the world, followed by a tour of Maramba Market. Relax or enjoy the many activities around Victoria Falls. Overnight.

Our guided tour of Victoria Falls (known by locals as "The Smoke that Thunders") gives us not only a chance to see one of the Seven Natural Wonders of the World but the opportunity to learn about how the falls were formed and the many customs and traditions that surround them. The tour ends with a visit to a local arts and craft center and lasts about two hours.

Our guided market tour will be to Maramba Market. It is the largest market in Livingstone and is colorful, vibrant and bustling with activity. Here the local people sell everything from brightly colored fabrics to fruit and vegetables and of course curios made from just about anything. Our guide will accompany us through the market teaching us some necessary bargaining skills with which we can purchase some very interesting and authentic artifacts. The tour lasts two hours. Return to the Royal Livingstone for dinner and evening at leisure.

On arrival you will be met and transferred to Radisson Blu Hotel Waterfront. Dine at the restaurant of your choice. Overnight.

Enjoy Cape Town at leisure or book one of our tours of local area attractions. Dine at the restaurant of your choice. Dining recommendation: Tobago's Restaurant in hotel or Jardine & 95 Keerom in the city center. Overnight.

Today you'll be transferred to Cape Town Airport for your return flight to Johannesburg.
