



SAMPLE ITINERARY

Spain – Wels Catfish

(Please note: Itinerary is subject to revision due to changes in flight schedules, weather and other operational factors. Be sure to have your valid passport. Please resist the tendency to over-pack.)

Day One

USA-BARCELONA

Plan to arrive at the airport no later than 3 hours prior to departure.

(Please advise flight schedule)

Day Two

BARCELONA-MEQUINENZA

After clearing immigration and customs, and collecting your baggage, proceed to ground transportation where you will be met by a representative who will transfer you to Mequinenza (2-3 hours) located on the banks of the famous Ebro River system. Upon arrival in Mequinenza you will stop at the Bavarian Guide Service Office where you will meet your guide and be taken to your apartment.

Day Three through Day Eight

FISHING FOR WELS CATFISH

After breakfast each day, your guided hunt for the great Wels Catfish begins. This great sportfish is becoming one of Europe's most popular gamefish. When conditions are right the Ebro river system offers some of the best Wels catfishing in Spain. The Wels Catfish has been known to reach over 200 pounds. The guide service has noted many 100+ pound catfish. Don't forget to keep an eye out for the other species available. These fish include the trophy Carp that reach over 30 pounds, and the predatory Zander that have prospered into double digits since the river system was damned. Overnight at apartment (dinner on own).

Day Nine

MEQUINENZA-BARCELONA-USA

Pack your bags and checkout from your apartment. You will then be transferred to Barcelona Airport for your international flight home.

(Please advise flight schedule)

NOTE: A U.S. PASSPORT (VALID FOR THREE MONTHS BEYOND RETURN DATE) IS REQUIRED FOR ENTRY INTO SPAIN

RECONFIRM FLIGHTS 72 HOURS PRIOR TO DEPARTURE

CHECK IN AT LEAST 3 HOURS PRIOR TO INTERNATIONAL FLIGHTS; 2 HOURS FOR DOMESTIC FLIGHTS
