



Packing Suggestions: Crocodile Bay Lodge, Costa Rica

Note: Please resist the tendency to over pack. The fewer luggages you have to manage, the easier it will be to get around.

Most important

- Passport (Tourist card will be provided on your international flight)
- Photocopy of passport photo page
- Airline ticket
- Pen (for filling out customs forms)
- Cash (credit cards are accepted in San Jose and at the lodge).
- Insurance: Accident; medical; baggage & cancellation

Clothing

- Comfortable shoes
- Long-sleeve shirts for fishing
- Tropical-weight pants for fishing
- Casual pants
- Casual shirts
- Shorts
- Tennis shoes/boat shoes
- T-shirts
- Bathing suit
- Underwear, pajamas
- Socks
- Lightweight rain gear
- Fishing cap or wide brim hat

Other

- Sunscreen / lip balm
- Aloe vera gel for sunburn
- Polarized sunglasses
- Toiletries
- Personal medications*
- Camera and film, videotapes, batteries, etc.
- Pepto Bismol (tablets)
- Extra personal fishing gear

** Note: If you are prone to seasickness, we recommend that you see your doctor and get a prescription for Trans Derm Scopos. These have proven to help with seasickness without the dorma effects of other seasickness medications.*

What is the tipping policy?

Tipping is a matter of personal preference and should be used only to reward good service. For those in doubt, here are some general guidelines. For those participating on our billfish excursions, it is customary to tip the captain and his mate. A \$25 tip per day per person, for both the captain and mate is customary for excellent service. Airport transfer/assistance service \$5-\$10 per passenger on departure from Costa Rica; hotel bellboys \$1 per bag. Gratuities may be paid in U.S. currency.
