



## **Packing Suggestions: Waterfall Resort, Alaska**

### ***Clothing***

Dress is casual. The lodge provides waterproof boots, bib overalls, jackets and a hat, as well as all fishing tackle and gear. Plan on dressing in layers to prepare for changing weather. We recommend packing:

- Long pants
- Shorts
- Sweaters
- Hooded sweatshirts
- Short-sleeve shirts
- A good quality rain suit
- Warm, water resistant gloves
- Hat
- Polarized sunglasses
- Camera and film or video camera, tapes & batteries
- Sunscreen
- Insect repellent
- Personal Toiletries
- Personal medications

### **Weather**

Prince of Wales Island has a cool, moist, maritime climate. Between May and September, daytime temperatures range from 50 to 75 degrees. It is not unusual for it to rain during this season.

### **Tackle**

The lodge provides all fishing tackle. Fly fishermen or other die-hard anglers are certainly welcome to bring their own gear.

### **Tipping Guidelines**

Tipping, while customary, is a very personal matter, and should be used to incentivate and reward good service. The following guidelines are just the lodge's suggestions to help you in your travel planning and budgeting, and should not be construed as a definitive "rule."

Guide: \$50 per angler per day

Lodge staff: \$30 (shared among all staff) per day

Staff tips are typically paid to management at end of week.
